List of coursework completed; or in progress.

5-7 items which reflect your professional growth and ability. Items may include, but are not restricted to: internships documents and products, class projects, lesson plans, lessons, workshops, seminars, media developed and used in instruction, and projects completed for purposes such as employment. Items included in this portfolio are:

> Provide a written summary for each item included in this section of the Portfolio. Each summary should explain why the item was included, what the document represents to the candidate, why the items was included, what the document represents to the candidate and a self assessment of the value of the document. Each summary should be 750 words or less.
